TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

This is to certify that the above-mentioned student completed the Bachelor of Education (Intermediate and Senior Phase) degree at the University of South Africa. The qualification was offered in English.

Students are required to spend 100 full days (20 weeks) physically at a school during practice teaching, mentored by qualified teachers and supervised by principals and professional assessors appointed by Unisa. They are expected to teach their chosen learning areas and subjects during their school experience. The presented lessons are compiled in a portfolio as reflective assignments and submitted to the University for final assessment. Module-specific academic lecturers responsible for the subject chosen by the student then assess the portfolio. This qualification includes teaching in a primary (grades 4-7) and secondary (grades 8-9) school.

During their classroom teaching experience, students need to carry out the following tasks:

- Classroom observations, compiling a lesson plan and executing a lesson according to the lesson plan
- Collecting and making relevant subject-related resources
- Adhering to time allocations / time management
- Meeting with mentor teachers and school management in the school for advice and support
- Carrying out basic assessments of work done during the lesson
- Attending to discipline, behavioral issues and basic classroom management and concerns
- Extra-mural activities such as sports coaching and cultural activities

The presented lessons were supervised in the following teaching practice modules:

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PST104F/TPN2601 Teaching Practice 1 - Observation 25 days
PST204J/TPN2602 Teaching Practice 2 - Grades 4-5 (10 to 11-year old) 25 days
PST304M/TPN3703 Teaching Practice 3 - Grades 6-7 (12 to 13-year old) 25 days
PST402N/TPN3704 Teaching Practice 4 - Grades 8-9 (14 to 15-year old) 25 days
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The student taught a selection from the following school subjects during the teaching practice period:

- Language Teaching
- Mathematics
- Natural Science
- Social ScienceArts & Culture
- Economic literacy and Entrepreneurship
- Physical Education and Sports coaching
